

Request for Proposal – Audit Services

Per R7-2-1042

If, under this Section, the governing board determines in writing that the use of competitive sealed bidding is either not practicable or not advantageous to the school district, a contract may be entered into by competitive sealed proposals. The governing board may make a class determination that it is either not practicable or not advantageous to the school district to procure specified types of materials or services by competitive sealed bidding. The competitive sealed proposal method may not be used for construction contracts.

If competitive sealed bidding is neither practicable or advantageous, then competitive sealed proposals may be used. The use of competitive sealed proposals is deemed necessary for the selection of audit services to compare the different price, quality, and contractual factors of the proposals submitted and award a contract in which price is not the determining.
