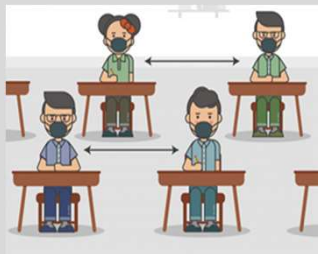
## WEDNESDAY-FRIDAY

- Students attend distance learning classes from home utilizing Google Classroom



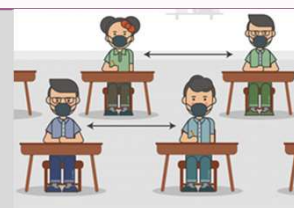

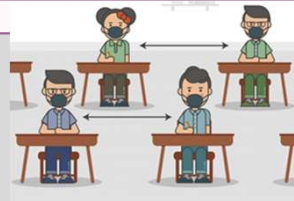

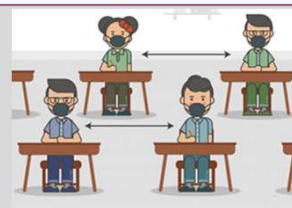

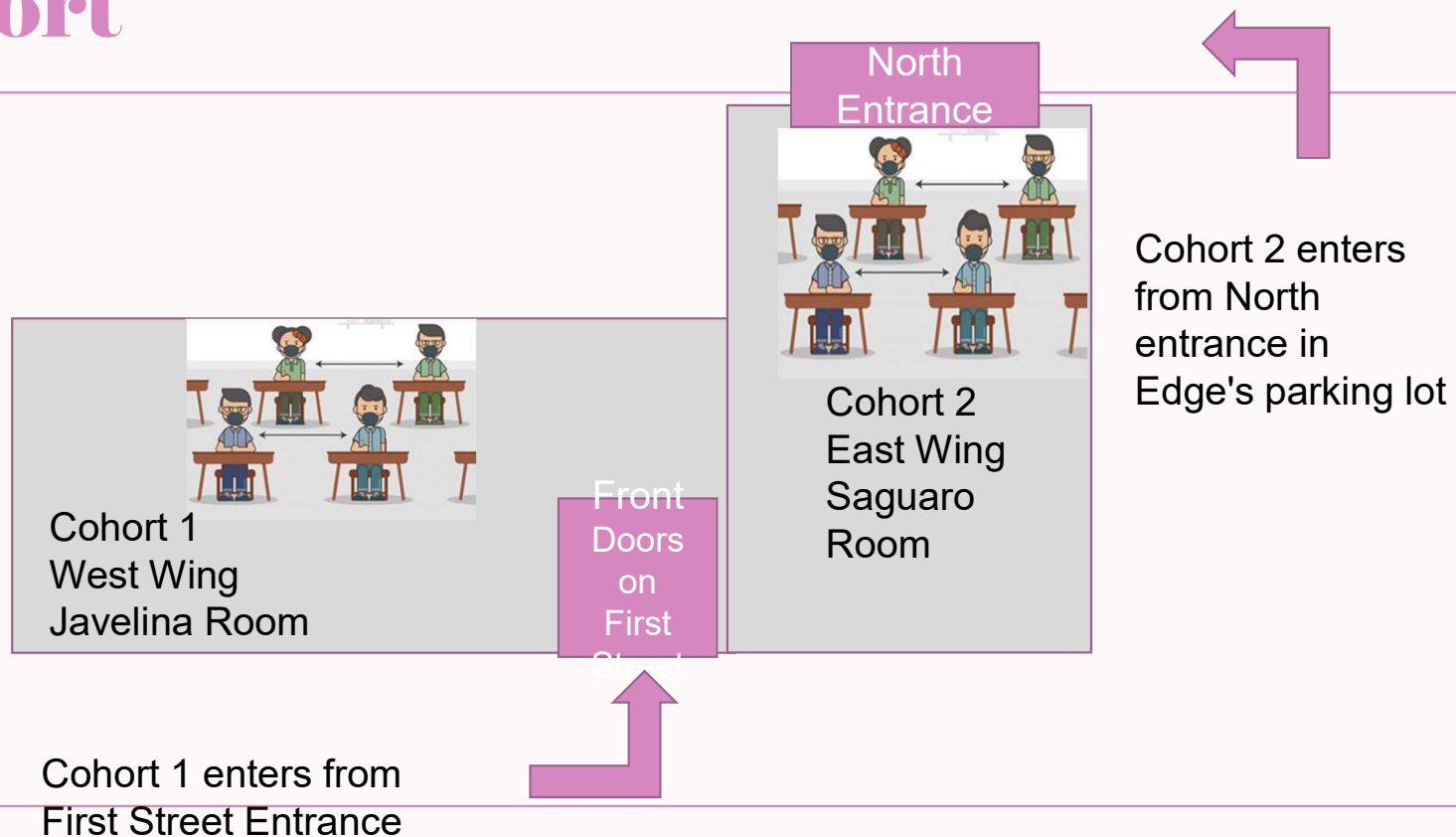

# Arriving To School

- Building opens at 8:30AM
- Arrive at your assigned entrance
- Temperature Checks using touchless thermometers (If temp is 100.4 degrees or higher student will be sent home)
- You will be asked health screening questions (If students answers yest to any question they will be sent home)
- Student uses hand sanitizer as they enter building
- Student goes straight to the assigned classroom

# Safety Protocols

- Facemasks required and must properly cover your mouth and nose
- Reduced class sizes to allow for maximum social distancing
- Enforcement of social distancing at all times.
- Seating Chart to ensure students have their own work- space

# Safety Protocols Continued

- Assigned restrooms for each cohort. 1 student signs out at a time.
- Each Cohort is assigned to 1 classroom and 1 wing of the building.
- No shared supplies.
- No shared devices. Students already assigned an Edge Chromebook are expected to bring their Chromebook on Mondays and Tuesdays. Students who have been working from home during distance learning on their own devices will be assigned a device to use at school.

# Safety Protocols

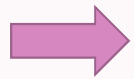
- Hepa filters in each classroom to remove contaminants from the air.

- Failure to comply may result in the student losing their seat in Hybrid In Person Learning.

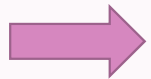
# FAQs

Students must be present on campus to be considered present for a class.

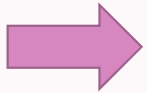
Question: Can a hybrid student move back to 100% distance learning



Yes. Hybrid students can decide they want to return to 100% distance learning. However, students will need to remain in 100% distance learning for the rest of the year.

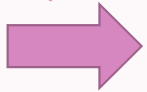
# FAQs

Question: Can students be added to the Hybrid learning option after the start of the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter?



This last interval for students to be added to the hybrid in-person learning option will be the week of April 5<sup>th</sup>.

All visitors to campus will have their temperature taking and be subject to health screening questions. Masks must be worn on campus.

## RETURN TO SCHOOL CRITERIA

If your student has a fever or other symptoms that could be related to COVID-19, and does NOT receive a negative COVID test or alternative physician diagnosis, the following criteria must be met to return to school:

1. At least 10 calendar days have passed since symptoms first appeared AND
2. Has been fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication.

Has your student been fever free without medication for 24 hours AND were they seen by a healthcare provider and diagnosed with something other than COVID-19?
