

# Administrator's Report for Edge Himmel Park

## May, 2021

### **Current Enrollment**

The current enrollment at Edge Himmel Park as of Friday, May 14<sup>th</sup> 92.

### **Enrollment Changes Over The Past Month**

Withdrawals: 5 (1 was a graduate, the other 4 were dropped for 10 straight days of absences without contact)

Enrolled: 9 total enrollments since our last board meeting

\*6 of the 9 enrollments were brand new students. 5 of the brand-new students enrolled in 5 day a week in-person learning. 1 new enrollment selected distance learning.

\*3 of the 9 enrollments since our last board meeting were returning students re-enrolling after being withdrawn for absences.

### **Enrollment and Recruitment Efforts With Charter School Capital**

We are currently working on curating a series of short videos for our website. The videos will cover the following topics:

- Class size, hours, and instructional model
- How to recover credit or accelerate your learning at Edge
- Counseling Supports
- Individualized instruction and support

Each video will feature a different staff member and will be curated over the next two weeks. When completed they will live on our website. Post-card mailers will be strategically mailed out to families with school age children in specific zip codes. A QR code on each post-card will direct recipients to the videos on our website.

Social Media posts and Social Media ads over the summer will focus on how Edge addresses learning loss.

### **Graduation Update**

Graduation is scheduled for Friday, May 28<sup>th</sup> at the Copper Ballroom at the Tucson Convention Center at 7PM. Board members are invited and encouraged to attend. The ceremony will celebrate the graduating classes of both 2020 and 2021!

Masks will be required at graduation. Guests will be seated at round tables that seat 8 per table, allowing the support persons of each student to sit together at a table. Tables will be arranged ten feet apart.

Edge Himmel Park currently has 3 graduates officially done. Another 5-12 may still graduate in the next 2 weeks.

Edge Himmel Park has 4 students from the class of 2020 who have confirmed their participation at this year's ceremony. We anticipate that number to increase to close to 10 in the next week or so.

### **Summer School Registrations**

Summer school is scheduled for June 14<sup>th</sup>-July 1<sup>st</sup>. Summer school is 12 school days long with classes meeting on a Monday-Thursday schedule. Edge will be utilizing ESSER 2 monies to ensure that summer school is free to students. Edge will offer Math, Science, and Social Studies courses during summer school. Students have the option of choosing in person learning or distance learning. Below are the current enrollment numbers for summer school:

Northwest students enrolled: 9

Himmel Park students enrolled: 19

Total # of students enrolled: 27

Breakdown of learning options selected in summer school:

Distance Learning: 12 students

In-person learning: 15 students

Breakdown by subject:

Math: 21 students (2 teachers)

Science: 4 students (1 teacher)

Social studies 3 students (1 teacher)

### **Calendar Updates**

On April 22<sup>nd</sup>, Wendi Miller and 4 students attended the WomenTechCouncil of Arizona's virtual She-Tech Conference. Students learned about careers in STEM and heard from local leaders in the field.

On April 26<sup>th</sup>, Edge received communication from the Arizona State Board of Charter Schools that our 10 Year Interval Review which included a virtual on-site visit was complete and satisfactory.

Edge wrapped up the standardized testing season in early May. ACT, ASVAB, AZM2, and AIMS Science tests were administered. A big thanks go to Irma Ojeda, our testing coordinator to make the process as smooth as possible.
