

Can my student go to school today?

(Answer ALL the three questions in the boxes below)

Do you believe your student may have been in contact with an individual who tested positive for COVID-19?

Have you been fully vaccinated from COVID-19, two weeks after last shot?

YES - If no symptoms, come to school

NO - Quarantine 10 days and review this flowchart again.

Notify the school if your student tests positive and follow the Return to School Criteria before returning to school.

Come to school

Is your student ill with cold/flu like symptoms?

(runny nose, congestion, sore throat, persistent cough, difficulty breathing, headache, chills, loss of taste/smell, significant muscle pain/aches, diarrhea or vomiting?)

Inform the school
Rest and recover
Call a healthcare provider if symptoms worsen
Follow Return to School Criteria

Come to school
If your student has not been absent for illness, go directly to class

RETURN TO SCHOOL CRITERIA

If your student has a fever or other symptoms that could be related to COVID-19, and does NOT receive a negative COVID test, the following criteria must be met to return to school:

1. At least 10 calendar days have passed since symptoms first appeared AND
2. Has been fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication.

Does your student have a fever of **100.4 or higher**?

If your student has not been absent for illness, go directly to class

Has your student been fever free without medication for 24 hours AND did the receive a negative COVID-19 test?
