COVID Updates AT Himmel Park:

Since the beginning of the school year, 5 students have tested positive for COVID-19. Of the five students who tested positive, two tested positive at school after attending class resulting in contact tracing and the need to have additional students quarantine. Fifty-four students have been tasked with quarantining in alignment with your mitigation protocols. That represents 51% of our student body. Managing COVID testing, contact tracing, and the required support person follow up requires multiple hours a day worth of work for several staff members.
